A new *Forest and Range Practices Act (FRPA)* Administration Bulletin (Number 16), "Interpretive Guidance Respecting the Extension of Woodlot Licence Plans" has just been completed. This bulletin will provide guidance for the extension of woodlot licence plans for woodlot practitioners.

The bulletin emphasizes the importance of a ministry driven process to review and extend woodlot licence plans that conform to the prescribed requirements in *FRPA*. It provides considerations for the review of plans to confirm conformance.
